

Breadth Requirements for the BA Degree

College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences (CHASS)

- English Composition:** ENGL 001A (or AP 3-5)
ENGL 001B (or AP 4-5)
ENGL 001C
- Foreign Language:** 4th quarter level (i.e., SPN 4, GER 15A, FREN4) of one language with grade of C or better (C- must be repeated). If using a language in which student has previous knowledge (high school or native language), student must take placement exam (dates of exams are found in current Schedule of Classes). If using a language in which student has had college level coursework, see Brenda or Laura prior to enrollment.
- Ethnicity:** One course taught by (or crosslisted with) Ethnic Studies Department. Counts also as either Humanities Elective or Social Science ElectiveBsee general catalog for designation as humanities or social science.
- World History:** HIST 010, 015, or 020 only. Recommended that students not take any of these courses until they have completed the English Composition requirement due to the writing requirements of these courses.
- Fine Arts:** One (1) course from Art, Art History, Creative Writing (poetry, fiction, or playwriting), Dance, Film and Visual Culture, Music, or Theatre.
- LIT/PHIL/RLST:** Two (2) courses from Literature (offered by the Departments of English, Comparative Literature and Foreign Languages, or Spanish and Portuguese); Philosophy, or Religious Studies.
- Humanities Elective:** One (1) additional course from History, the Fine Arts, Literature, Philosophy, Religious Studies, a foreign language at level 3 or higher (in a language other than the one being used to fulfill the foreign language requirement), Linguistics, Creative Writing (journalism courses), or a humanities course from Ethnic Studies, HMSS, Latin American Studies, or Women=s Studies (see general catalog for humanities designation).
- ECON or POSC:** One (1) course from Economics or Political Science
- ANTH or SOC:** One (1) course from Anthropology or Sociology
- Soc. Science Electives:** Two (2) additional courses from Anthropology, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, or a social science course from Environmental Science (those crosslisted with Economics only), Ethnic Studies, HMSS, Latin American Studies, or Women=s Studies (see general catalog for social science designation).
- Math/Science:** Will be met with Math/Science requirements for the PSYC or HMDV major.

NOTE: All courses must earn a minimum of 4 units of credit (i.e., students can NOT use two (2) 2-unit dance or music courses to fulfill the Fine Arts requirement).
